

How to Petrify Your Own Wood A Harvard University group has developed a way to petrify plant tissue in the lab. They use ethyl silicate and cilicic acid which produces a petrification very similar to what is opalized wood. The reported technique can petrify wood in a matter of days.

Which Weighs More..... a pound of gold or a pound of feathers?

There is two weight systems used in the U.S. The troy system with 12 ounces to the pound, traditionally used for precious metal and the avoirdupois system with 16 ounces to the pound is used in general commerce. Obviously a pound of feathers at 16 ounces to the pound will weigh more than a pound of gold at 12 ounces to the pound.
